

Our Golden Rules Behaviour Policy

We believe that children flourish best when their personal, social and emotional needs are met and where there are clear and developmentally appropriate expectations for their behaviour. We aim to teach them to behave in a socially acceptable way and to understand the needs and rights of others

These are our Golden Rules:

1. Be kind to each other
2. Share nicely
3. Help each other
4. Don't hurt each other
5. Remember our manners
6. Look after the toys and nursery
7. Remember to ask an Auntie for help

Unacceptable behaviour

An Auntie will sit with them on a chair after putting their name peg on the black cloud.

We will explain to them why their behaviour is unacceptable and encourage them to think about their actions.

We will encourage them to apologise, if needed, using age appropriate methods.

When they display good behaviour after unacceptable behaviour, they will be put back onto the rainbow.

If they revisit the time out chair for a 2nd visit that session, a black cloud will be given to them to take home, with details of why on the back.

In the event of a child repeatedly hurting other children or staff, as a last resort parents will be contacted and requested to collect their child for the rest of that session.

Good behaviour

We promote good behaviour by putting their named peg on the sunshine, so that it is visual for the children and staff to see, and they will be given a sunshine picture to take home with details of why they received it on the back, they will also put a spot on the chart next to their name. When they fill all the boxes, they will receive a "star" badge and certificate to take home.
